### **Latest guidelines re singing**

The current situation (though the guidelines are difficult to interpret) is that we are now allowed to sing, provided it is in a Covid-secure setting, which the Hastoe Village Hall is (maximum number of people allowed 20).

### **Doodle poll**

The results of the Doodle Poll showed that 42 people would be keen to restart.

### **Decision NOT to restart**

After a wide-ranging discussion, however, the meeting concluded that the worsening Coronavirus situation meant that it was very likely that, were we to restart, we would be closed down again very soon. There is also a feeling that the Covid situation is very unstable and will probably get worse before it gets better. So, reluctantly, the meeting decided that the choir would not restart before Christmas 2020.

### **Singing in small groups**

However, Marie would offer the hall to individual groups of six who wanted to meet and sing but they would have to taken responsibility for payment and cleaning of the hall, as well as ensuring adherence to the rules on social distancing etc. It should be noted that there is no piano or keyboard in the hall.

Adrian suggested that any small groups working in this way might like to include Vivaldi's Gloria as something to work towards, so that as and when the full choir can get together, this could be put together quickly.
