Possibility of a “Come and Sing Messiah” event in December

Marie put forward a suggestion by Jeanette Ager that she, Phillip Conway-Brown and Kathryn Jenkin might be prepared to come and sing through the Messiah with members of the choir, not as a performance but simply for the choir’s own benefit.

Marie had approached St. Peter’s Berkhamsted, but they had concluded this would not be in line with their Covid-19 guidelines. Adrian advised the meeting that St. Peter’s Church Choir had met (17 singers in all) and recorded some Christmas music for use in the services and that it had worked well, but that, on balance, we should not approach St. Peter’s again, the idea having already been rejected.

Chris Sanders mooted the possibility Abbot’s Langley Church being approached and volunteered to sound them out and find out how many people would be allowed to take part.

If the church gave the go-ahead, CCC would visit and make their own risk assessment and plan.

Obviously we would expect to give the church a donation - so members of the choir wishing to participate may be asked to pay a £5 donation to attend.

The date would hopefully be in mid December, but we would obviously come back to the detail, once we have a decision from the church.
